Excellent postdocs and recent PhD graduates who would like to apply for the Marie Curie Individual Postdoctoral Fellowship 2021 are invited to join the excellent research environment at our faculty. With an EU-funded Marie Skłodowska Curie Fellowship, you could spend 1-2 years at one of <u>our research groups</u>. We offer candidates an excellent research environment, <u>discipline related knowledge centres</u> and access to novel <u>research facilities</u>. The Faculty of Architecture and the Built Environment has a strong focus on 'design-oriented research', combining a robust research profile with passion and creativity. We are working on improving the built environment with the help of a broad set of disciplines, including architectural design, urban planning, building technology, social sciences, process management, and geo-information science. Selected candidates will receive support from dedicated staff to write a successful proposal for the MSCA-PF-2021 call (*expected* deadline 15 September 2021).

Marie Curie fellowship:

Formal aspects:

- Experience level: at least a PhD
- Mobility rule: at the time of deadline, you may not have lived in the Netherlands for more than 12 months during the previous 3 years
- Expected Submission deadline: 15 September 2021
- Earliest possible start date: 8 months after call deadline
- Duration of fellowship: between 12 and 24 months

- 22 April '21: deadline Eol
- End April '21: administrative check
- May '21: internal selection + interview by host and research group
- End May '21: communicate selection
- June-July '21: development of the proposal
- 15 September '21: EU submission

Evaluation

The evaluation will take a maximum of 4 weeks and includes an assessment of the documents and a mandatory interview. The assessment will be based on the following criteria:

- your fulfilment of our eligibility criteria
- the scientific quality of your research idea
- the societal relevance of your research idea
- the quality of your curriculum vitae

After the review we will inform you of our decision and if you are selected to prepare a proposal as a MC-PF candidate with TU Delft as host organisation. *Please note that the review procedures includes a mandatory online interview.* For questions please contact us at <u>research-bk@tudelft.nl</u>.
