FACULTY OF ARCHITECTURE AND THE BUILT ENVIRONMENT PROVISIONAL Course packages for Exchange students 2024-2025

Due to issues concerning scheduling and availability, we cannot offer our students a free choice of subjects.

During the Autumn/first semester (starting in September), we offer:

- For Master level students complete 'MSc 1' fixed course packages.
- For Bachelor level students English taught Minor Programmes.

During the **Spring/second semester** (starting in February), we offer:

- For **Master** Level students a 15 EC MSc2 design course + a course package of 3 elective courses (5 EC each).
- For **Bachelor** Level students there are NO minor packages available. BSc/undergraduate students cannot apply for the spring semester.

Below you will find the list of course packages we offer. Since we cannot guarantee enrolment in your first choice, it is obligatory to mention <u>a second choice and a third choice</u> in the application system.

Please be aware that:

- The course catalogue for the academic year 2024-2025 will be updated around the end of April 2024 (online course catalogue), so changes may occur. For students applying for the fall 2024: Due to a Bachelor and Master renewal it is also possible that a few new developed courses may not yet be published in the studyguide when applying.
- It is not possible to combine courses of different packages or to choose electives, it is however possible to do part of a course package as long as you meet the 24 EC requirement.
- Before the start of the exchange period, the final fixed course package will be confirmed. After the fixed course package is confirmed, it is no longer possible to change or add courses.
- Courses which are listed here for Spring will change and this is just an indication. Students do not apply yet for courses in the Spring.

Once your courses have been confirmed, it is not allowed to switch programmes.
