Proof of English language proficiency for EngD programmes

EngD applicants are required to provide evidence of proficiency in the English language.

Valid English language tests

1. TOEFL:

- TOEFL IBT test. TOEFL MyBest Scores is not accepted
- minimum requirement of an overall band score of 100
- with scores of at least 21 points for each section
- test scores have been awarded within the last 2 years

OR

2. IELTS:

- IELTS Academic version
- overall band score of 7.0
- with scores of at least 6.5 points for each section
- test scores have been awarded within the last 2 years

Exempted from the test

- 1. applicants who hold a passport from the United Kingdom, Ireland, USA, Canada (English-speaking part), Australia or New Zealand and attended secondary school/college in that country
- 2. applicants who hold an English-taught Master's degree. If during the selection process it is deemed that the English proficiency of the applicant with an English-taught Master's degree does not meet the requirements, they may also be asked to do a test
