

11th Conference on Traffic and Granular Flow 28-30 October 2015



Scope

The traffic and granular flow conference brings together scientists with different backgrounds to discuss flows from the perspective of the individual particle/agent and from the aggregate flow perspective. Besides the classical topics of granular flow and highway traffic, its scope includes but is not limited to data transport (Internet traffic), pedestrian and evacuation dynamics, intelligent transport systems, intercellular transport, swarm behaviour and collective dynamics of other biological systems.

All papers accepted for a poster or oral presentation will appear in the book of proceedings. A selection of these will be invited to publish an extended version of their paper in a special (journal) issue. The conference is set up for easy exchange of scientific ideas between researchers, experienced and starting PhD Students. This allows to explore and show opportunities for interdisciplinary research.
