
- Established in 1984


Scientific and research activities

- Main research focus is related to finding solutions that will enable mobility in a more efficient, secure, and environmentally sustainable way
- Faculty continuously monitors the new trends in the transport system's development and has defined about 40 topics that our experts deal with through scientific research projects
- Some of the main research topics:
 - sustainable transport,
 - the safety of all road users,
 - application of big datasets in transport,
 - cooperative transport systems,
 - virtual and augmented reality in logistics,
 - GNSS systems
 - innovations in airplane control
 - innovations in ATM systems
 - drones, etc.




Research infrastructure

- Three labs certificated by external body

















Scientific and research activities

- Projects founded by: H2020, Horizon Europe, Croatia science found government, university...
- AeroSTREAM Strengthening Research and Innovation Excellence in Autonomous Aerial Systems – strengthening capacity for innovation for research institutions in higher education
- IVORY 'AI for Vision Zero in Road Safety' (Horizon Europe) education of the new researchers
- ELABORATOR Research and Innovation actions for support the implementation of the Climate-neutral and Smart Cities Mission – development of methodology, tools and recommendation for urban planners and companies to enhance innovations
- OLGA hOListic & Green Airports reducing negative impact of air transport industry on environment
- Sustainable Urban Mobility Boost Smart Toolbox 1&2 (EIT-H2020) –
 identification of urban zones with high percentage of personal cars and
 detection of sustainable transport modes





Professional activities
