A new experiment involving speed dating is being set up in collaboration with the social psychology department at the VU university of Amsterdam for February 2015. The experiment will involve measuring the volunteers' hormone levels, behaviour using cameras, microphones, and wearable sensors.

These topics will be related to devising statistical models to automatically predict socially relevant phenomena from real behavioural data. The experimental design has not been finalised - this is the time to steer the experiment to things you are interested in!

Each project student will be expected to interface with an interdisciplinary team, and in particular, with masters students from social psychology from the VU university of Amsterdam.
