1.1 Changes existing profile

Check the version of Thunderbird. It has to be equal or higher then version 77.0. b1. Otherwise an update is necessary

- Click with right mouse-button on the mailbox.
- Choose settings.
- Select server settings.
- Change server name to outlook.office365.com. Port 993.
- Connection security : SSL/TLS
- Authentication method: change to OAuth2
