- organisation and strategy formation within science, nationally and internationally










# NWO's role in research funding (nexus)


# NWO contributes € 550 million to the topsectors in '18/'19



## Funding opportunities in 2018 / 2019

#### **Public-private partnerships**

- NWO Cross-over call: 40 M€ budget; large consortia; societal challenges; call for expressions of interest will open April/May (tentative)
- Materials NL Challenges call: 5 M€ budget; expected scope: designer materials & engineering materials; details later this year; www.nwo.nl/en/policies/top+sectors/materials+science
- Sustainable Living Labs: 5 M€ budget; cross-over Logistics, Water & Maritime and Energy with focus on Logistics; call open for grants for consortium formation; matchmaking March 6th; www.nwo.nl/en/research-and-results/programmes/magw/sustainable-living-labs/index.html
- Transitions & Behavior: 8,4 M€ budget; broad call aimed at human behavior and the human factor in transitions (e.g. the energy transition); call open & matchmaking: september 2018 (tentative)

# PhD@Sea: programme for 7 – 8 PhD projects with industry

- Motivation: Need for development of fundamental knowledge base and highly-skilled human capital
- Scope: fundamental & multi-disciplinary including social sciences
- Total budget: ~ M€ 2.1 (i.e. M€ 1.5 by NWO, 30% private co-financing)
- Current status: design of programmatic setup; approaching private parties for co-financing
- Time line:
  - Q3: installing programme and review committee; design call text;
  - Q4: launch call
