- Always state the source.
- Copyright free or content with an open license is always ok.
- Direct links are preferred, get permission or [ask the Library for access](#).

Use Links

How many pages

You can use up to 40 pages from publications in your lessons, on the condition that it is not more than 20% of the original publication. **Try to limit to 25 pages or use a hyperlink due to high costs.**

For all your students

Use Educational Resource Lists

Use the [Educational resource lists tool](#) to organise lists of digital learning materials. Share these in BrightSpace to give students easy access and improve student engagement.



How many images

There is no maximum of images in your presentations.

Under these two conditions:

- No more than 10 works by the same maker.
- No more than 25 images from the same work.



Avoid legal issues

Use copyrighted materials as intended. Avoid fees or penalties.
