

# How to publish an open access (OA) book

Definition of book/monograph for this workflow: a long-form academic work/book on a single research topic. This includes (peer-reviewed) edited collections and critical editions, but does not include book chapters, reference works, conference proceedings, dissertations, textbooks nor translations.

## Step 1 Choose an OA publisher
