

Enabling WiFi calling on your Samsung Android phone


Step 1. Go to the **Phone** app.




Step 2. Tap on the Menu icon (3 dots)



Step 3. Tap on Settings.




Step 4. Tap on Wi-Fi calling.



Step 5: If not enabled: enable Wi-Fi calling by setting it to **on**. Then, select **Wi-Fi preferred**.

Step 6: You are now able to make and recieve calls over Wi-Fi.
