Grant information

Erasmus+ Study Scholarships are available to you, as a TU Delft student who will study at a partner university within the EU for 2 to 12 months. TU Delft is able to provide financial support for a maximum of 360 days of your stay abroad per study cycle (BSc/MSc).

The countries that participate in the ERASMUS+ programme are divided into three groups:

Top ups

- **Travelling sustainably**

If you travel by train, bus etc. you can apply for a €50 travel top up. You need to travel to and from the host sustainably.

- **Disability**

For example, you have a disability (dyslexia, ADHD) and/or health problems

Provide a medical certificate or official statement about your physical or health problems from a doctor and/or medical/health institute with your application for the Erasmus + scholarship.

Students can receive €250 per month (per 30 days).

- **Financial need**

Financial need can only be provided by handing in the letter from DUO that you receive additional funding. Students receiving DUO finance only, are not eligible for the Top up.
