TU Delft does not allow a purely virtual mobility or a combination of physical and virtual mobility for semester exchange. Physical presence at the Host University for the whole semester is required because we believe that this contributes most to the acquisition of intercultural competences. In order to remain eligible for the Erasmus+ scholarship your physical stay at the Host University must be at least 2 months (60 days).
