- Workshops for teaching assistants and mentors

Students' reflections

"As discussed in the team dynamics session, frustration is a natural part of collaboration. These disagreements can actually be benficial is we handle them well."

Six main areas of teamwork skills:

- Teamwork basics: how can the team members organize the team tasks and activities and create a solid base for collaboration?
- **Team roles:** what are the preferred roles of the individual team members and how can they collaborate effectively?
- Meetings and decision making: how to organize effective meetings with sufficient decision-making power?
- Effective communication: how to give effective feedback and solve conflicts?
- Team dynamics: how do the team members influence each other's needs, feelings, beliefs, and behaviors? How to use this information to motivate each other?
- Diversity: how to prevent and handle miscommunication that is a result of differences in speech, belief, tradition, or background?
