Transitional Measures 2024-2025

Below listed transitional measures, to be implemented as of 1 September 2024, are a result of changes made in the faculty's master's programmes and the courses belonging to these programmes.

Important notes:

- Current Master AUBS and GM students are allowed to complete their degree programme according to the same requirements that applied during the
 first academic year of their enrolment.
 (see TER, Art. 1.38 in the Student Charter AUBS 2023-2024 and Student Charter Geomatics 2023-2024).
- Courses offered in academic year 2023-2024 not listed below will be taught again in academic year 2024-2025 (see for a full course overview: Master AUBS and Master Geomatics in the Study Guide 2024-2025).
- The Study Guide 2024-2025 of the <u>Master AUBS</u> is structured differently compared to the previous academic year.
 Instead of a general list of all master's electives offered by the faculty (the so-called 'AR Electives'), there are now Q3 elective lists and Q4 elective menus specified for each Master AUBS track. The Study Guide structure of the Master Geomatics has not changed.

Reading instructions:

Reading left to right, you will first find the course that was offered in the academic year of 2023-2024 and before, followed by the replacement course, including the number of credits (EC) and the quarter (Q) the course was taught.

If there is no replacement course for the academic year 2024-2025, it is indicated by a '-'.

Under 'Remarks' all information about a specific transitional measure is summed up including possible repair opportunities.
