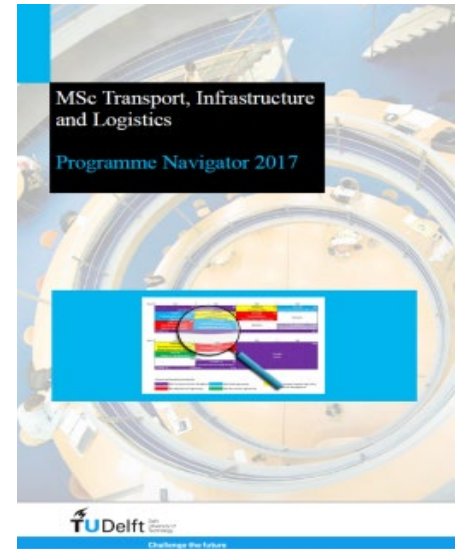

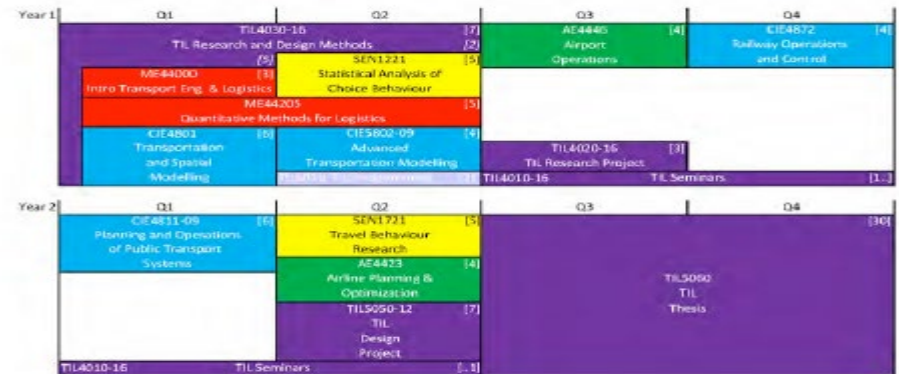

Experience

- 'Live' projects, real commissioners, working experience / internship
- Apply what you learned earlier
- Interfaculty supervising team (TPM/3mE/CiTG)

Very important

- Largest project before thesis project: P2 = 2,5-3,5 days per week
- Complex: Team, supervisors, different aims and opinions
- Active: Build team, find commissioner/project, manage project
- Plan *early* – preferable well before P0
- You can only do a few courses/exams in parallel with TIL5050

TIL5060 – MSc Thesis project

Experience

- External: ‘Live’ projects, real commissioners, working experience
- Internal projects – linked to ongoing research @TUD
- A lot of freedom, but the clock is running swiftly
- Plan your tasks and private life
- Challenging content, and sometimes mentally challenging

Supervision:

- Interfaculty supervising team (TPM/3mE/CEG)
