Examples of Final Defence and Graduation procedures

- 1 hour (TPM prof. van Wee, prof. Tavasszy): 1 meeting, 1 room, public presentation and defence, questions by audience and then by thesis assessment committee. Separate grading session.
- 2 hours (CiTG) prof. van Arem, prof. Hoogendoorn, prof. Goverde, prof. Hagenzieker.
- 2 hours (TPM prof. Verbraeck): 2 meetings, 2 rooms. Starts with exam meeting with grading, followed by a public presentation and defence, questions by audience only. Mark given directly.
- 2,5 hours (3mE prof. Negenborn, dr. Schott). 2 meetings, 2 rooms. Starts with public presentation and defence of about 45 minutes. Next 15 minutes break. Then 30-45 minutes oral exam with the Assessment Committee finished with grading session. If the candidate has passed, then a short session with the family in which the MSc Diploma is signed by the (now) MSc graduate.
- * Where professor is written, associate professors with UTQ and ius promovendi could also chair a Msc TIL exam session
