
MSc Transport, Infrastructure and Logistics **T**UDelft

The MSc programme Transport, Infrastructure and Logistics (TIL) is a two-year comprehensive programme that provides graduates with a comprehensive view of the field of transport, infrastructure and logistics. TIL graduates have up-to-date knowledge of transport policy making and spatial planning, design of transport systems, supply chains and infrastructure networks and the operation, management and control of these systems. This is an overview of the structure of the programme.

Fundamentals and Projects – 28 EC

The TIL master programme exists of fundamentals (compulsory courses), specialisations and electives.




Specialisations

There are four specialisations offered in the TIL master's programme. You can choose one of the following four:


Transport Governance (TG) – 27 EC


Focusing on the development and assessment of transport, spatial and environmental policy, as well as on economic impacts of infrastructure and spatial planning.



Transport Networks (TN) – 28 EC


Focusing on the design of transport service and infrastructure networks in the context of urban design, spatial planning and regional economy.





Traffic Operations (TO) – 27 EC


Focusing on the operational management and control of traffic in transport systems, as well as on the advanced technologies and methodologies in vehicles that facilitate these processes.



Logistics Systems (LS) – 26 EC

Focusing on the control and optimisation of transportation and production systems, as well as on the supply

chains to which they belong.
