Supplement to the TER 2022/2023

Supplement to TER 2022-2023 with regard to admission requirements for BSc and MSc programmes

1a. Admission to Bachelor's degree programmes (Article 3)

Article 3 is supplemented with Sections 3a, 3b and 3c concerning conditional admission, and reads:

HBO propedeuse -> bacheloropleiding

- 3a. For the 2022-2023 academic year, in addition to Section 1 of this article, students referred to in Subsection a of this Section may be admitted conditionally provided that they:
 - By 1 August 2022 at the latest, have submitted a completion recommendation from their HBO (University of Applied Sciences) to TU Delft, showing that the prospective student has obtained at least 50 of the 60 ECTS of the first year and that it is reasonable for the student to complete the relevant propaedeutic phase before 1 January 2023, and
 - on the basis of which the degree programme has made a positive assessment and
 - for supplementary requirements, see <u>BSc programmes</u>

If, on 1 January 2023, students have not met the admission requirements referred to in article 3a, they will be unenrolled from the degree programme.

Internationale VO EU -> bacheloropleiding

- 3b. For the 2022-2023 academic year, in addition to Section 1 of this article, students referred to in Subsection b of this Section may be admitted conditionally provided that they before 1 January 2023, they:
 - Will graduate from secondary school in a country from the European region and
 - Provide TU Delft with a graduation recommendation from their secondary school no later than 31 August 2022, which indicates that it is reasonable for the student to complete the relevant programme before 1 January 2023, including an explanation of the national legislation applicable to the student.

If, on 1 January 2023, students have not met the admission requirements referred to in article 3b, they will be unenrolled from the degree programme.

Internationale VO CXC ->bacheloropleiding

- 3c. For the 2022-2023 academic year, in addition to Section 1 of this article, students referred to in Subsection c of this Section may be admitted conditionally provided that they before 1 January 2023, they:
 - Will pass the secondary school diploma/CXC examination and
 - Provide TU Delft with a graduation recommendation from their secondary school no later than 31 August 2022, which indicates that it is reasonable for the student to complete the relevant programme before 1 January 2023.

If, on 1 January 2023, students have not met the admission requirements referred to in article 3c, they will be unenrolled from the degree programme.

1b. Admission to the Master's degree programme (Article 3)

Article 3 is supplemented with Section 3a and Section 3b with regard to conditional admission, which reads:

For the 2022-2023 academic year, in the context of the outbreak of Covid-19, students who were enrolled at a Dutch university or HBO (University of Applied Sciences) in the 2021-2022 academic year may be conditionally admitted provided that, on 31 August 2022, they:

- have a deficit not exceeding 10 EC for the Bachelor's degree audit of the Bachelor's programme referred to in this article, or
- have a deficit not exceeding 10 EC for completion of the bridging programme referred to in this article, but:
- meet the supplementary requirements, see MSC programmes

If, on 31 August 2023, students have not met the admission requirements referred to in Section 1 of this article, they will be unenrolled from the degree programme.

The foregoing does not apply to the student who used the regulation applicable in the academic year 2021/2022 or in the academic year 2020/2021 in connection with the Covid-19 outbreak for conditional admission in the event of a deficit not exceeding 15 EC.
