

# Registration to TU Delft Minors | Deadlines 2024-2025



The registration periods and placement procedures for selection minors and non-selection minors differ. Therefore it is important that you clearly decide well in advance whether you want to take either a selection minor or a non-selection minor. Your choice may have consequences.

### Selection minor

Selection

## Via EduXchange

Additional requirements apply to selection minors, such as a request for extra documentation. You can find more information about the admission criteria on the website of the selection minor in question.

Late registration period for TUDelft minors only | 1 - 15 May 2024 (13:00-23:59)

\*Not every selection minor offers the possibility of late registration. This may be because, for example, a selection minor is full, or because the selection minor itself has indicated that it does not have a late registration period.

Placement in a selection minor is final. Be aware that, once you have been given final placement in a selection minor, you may no longer de-register.

### Non-selection minor

#### **Registration period**

15 May - 31 August 2024 (13:00-23:59)

### Placement method

First come, first served based

Max. Credits final placements 30 EC

### Via EduXchange

You may register for a maximum of 30 credits per year (including your individual minor or selection minor).

It is at your own risk to withdraw and re-register for another minor. There is a limited number of places available.
