The project

The ACHI project: an initiative bridging theory and practice in Ghana's horticulture sector. Our ACHI program targets the motivated and enthusiastic Ghanaian youth. It is a collaboration with the 5 horticultural colleges in Ghana and Holland Greentech Ghana (HGT). The project addresses the gap between textbook knowledge and real-world agricultural practices. The program involves entrepreneurship education and horticulture practicals.



ACHI is a 4-month course with weekly classes and group work assignments offered by experts from the horticulture colleges, Delft University of Technology and Holland Greentech. All learning activities help the Ghanaian students in becoming more entrepreneurial in horticulture.
